2. A summary of the labourmarket

Mo i Rana's differentiated business community provides good job opportunities for both men and women. Rana municipality pursues an active policy that facilitates social and business development that attracts people and companies alike. In 2019, the unemployment rate in the municipality was only 2.2 per cent. This indicates an optimistic business environment where both private and public employers recognise their staff as their key asset.

Mo Industrial Park is the leading industrial development zone in Northern Norway. One hundred and eight businesses are located in the park, ranging from recycled steel products to fish farming and district heating from the surplus heat of the industrial processes. In total, around 2,500 people work in the industry park, which is known for its ambitious goals relating to climate, sustainability and the circular economy. As Rana is rich in minerals, another important employer is the mining company Rana Gruber. The largest companies have daily links with the world market. In 2018, the companies at Mo Industrial Park had exports worth NOK 5.5 billion.

The municipality of Rana also has a strong public sector that provides good government services on behalf of the Norwegian state, with the whole of Norway as users, as well as regional and municipal services.

The largest hospital in Helgeland is situated here offering a broad range of health disciplines. The Mo i Rana branch of the National Library of Norway is internationally renowned for its digitalisation of cultural heritage and collaborates with prestigious libraries and universities around the world. Mo i Rana has a flourishing IT environment: from Skatteetaten (the Norwegian Tax Administration), Statens innkrevingssentral (the Norwegian National Collection Agency) and Evry, producing and monitoring fraud prevention for all credit cards in Northern Europe, to TAG Sensors, producing temperature sensors with tracking for the food industry worldwide.

The city and the region have a range of international businesses, with significant exports of metals, iron ore and energy. The processing industry is an important pillar in the private sector. We are home to Northern Norway's leading industrial expertise in aquaculture and fish-processing, engineering and specialised manufacturing. We have industries based on knowledge and innovation, world-leading technology and natural resources. The people that work here thus play an important role in the creation of products that the world needs and demands.

Rana Development Agency (Rana Utvikling) is the municipality's business development agency, and is responsible for implementing the municipality's business plan. The Agency facilitate new business activities and help to improve the framework conditions for businesses. Thus, the agency offer courses in business development and support for funding applications for both start-ups and established businesses. There is also a co-working space, Væxt, which is free for use by start-ups.

3.1 Research and development

Campus Helgeland

Campus Helgeland is a collaborative hub for education and development, offering study programmes and courses from **Nord University** and **UiT The Arctic University of Norway** and housing a number of regional development actors such as Kunnskapsparken Helgeland, Rana Utvikling AS, Innovation Norway and Arctic Cluster Team. The campus hosts around 470 students from Nord University and 330 students from partner institutions. It was established in 2013 and is one of Norway's newest campuses.

Among the study programmes here you will find pedagogy (five-year master's programme), nursing (bachelor's degree), engineering (bachelor's degree), finance and administration, and business development, as well as shorter programmes and single topics.

3.2 Education

Mo i Rana offers a wide range of choices for education and career development. It hosts campuses for Nord University and UiT The Arctic University of Norway. Polarsirkelen High School has 1,150 students and a staff of about 300. The junior high school is Norway's largest and is situated in the town centre. The school has recently been modernised and offers various optional language courses, such as Spanish, Russian, French and German. It is also possible to choose from several other extra subjects, including crafts, theatre, sports and more. In March 2021, the Science Centre of Nordland will open in town.

Polarsirkelen VGS

This high school is one of Nordland County's largest upper-secondary schools and is the school offering the most educational programmes in one school. It has around 1,150 students and 300 staff, distributed over 11 different study programmes.

Study preparation education programme: study specialisation, music, dance and drama, sports subjects, media and communication, art, design and architecture.

Vocational education programme: health and upbringing subjects, building and construction engineering, electrical subjects, engineering and industrial production, restaurant and food subjects.

Students receive instruction either individually or in groups.

3.4 Industry



The Norwegian National Collection Agency (NCA) is an agency organised under the Norwegian Tax Administration. The NCA's task is to collect on various state claims. In total, the NCA has 35 clients in the government administration and collects on 188 different types of claims.

>>> The agency employs approximately 370 people in Mo i Rana. Main responsibilities: written and oral case processing and counselling, which includes contact with its users via telephone, letter and digital services. It also performs record keeping, mail processing, registration of requirements and document handling.

The Norwegian Welfare Administration (NAV)

NAV is the Norwegian public welfare agency, which consists of state labour and welfare services as well as municipal welfare agencies. It is responsible for a third of the state budget in Norway, administrating programmes such as unemployment benefits, pensions, child benefits etc. In Mo i Rana, NAV has two departments: NAV economic support and NAV service centre. In total, these departments have 235 employees: sociologists, social scientists, lawyers, humanists, economists, educators and others with a university or college background.

3.9 Health

The hospital has approximately 500 employees.
